Bring along a pair of binoculars and meet the naturalist on the Expedition Trail located behind the naturalist office to find out. (Unfortunately, this bird is weather-dependent so keep your fingers crossed for clear skies.)*

10:00 AM *THE WONDERS of OLD MAN'S CAVE – *Meet the naturalist at the Naturalist Cabin for a short hike and discover some facts about the history of the area and the rock formations that are found throughout the park.*

2:00 PM HOCKING'S BIRDS OF PREY - *Join the naturalist at the Naturalist Cabin for a closer look at Ohio's hawks, owls, eagles and vultures.*
